The author was for many years a resident of St. Thomas, and his work has the value of affording information acquired at first hand. The geographic manuals like Reclus s The Earth and its inhabitants and Stanford s Compendium of geography and travel give good summary accounts of the history and natural features of the islands. The negotiations for the purchase of the islands in 1865-1869 are well set forth in James Parton s The Danish islands: Are we bound in honor to pay for them? and in briefer form in Curtis s The United States and Foreign Powers and Wharton s A Digest of the international law of the United States.
