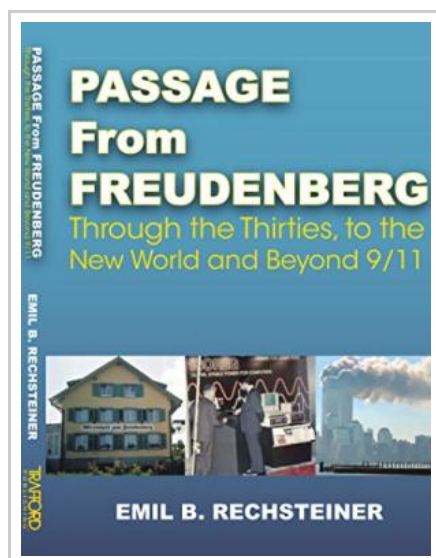




Passage from Freudenberg: Through the Thirties, to the New World and Beyond 9/11
